Influenza is a virus that infects people each year, causing severe illness and sometimes death. The flu vaccination provides the best protection against this unpredictable virus.

You are eligible for a free flu vaccine if you are:

- 1. Aged 65 years and over
- 2. Aged 6 months to under 65 years in a clinical risk
- 3. Pregnant
- 4. Carers
- Close contacts of immunosuppressed individuals
- Frontline workers in a health or social care setting

Your consultation will be with a qualified pharmacist in a private room if needed. The pharmacist can supply you with some medicines, where appropriate, and advice without you having to see your GP first

The consultation is free, and if the pharmacist agrees that you need medicine, they will be provided free of charge for people who get free prescriptions.

We hope this service will reduce the number of people seeking treatment via a prescription from their GP or out of hours (OOH) provider, or via a walk-in centre or accident and emergency
